in the 100th Anniversary (Leap) Year of the English District

July 1st, 2011 - June 30th, 2012

You are encouraged to offer daily personal prayers, congregational, school, classroom, staff, Synodical, District, and Circuit prayers to the Lord, our God, the Blessed Trinity, according to your custom of devotions and prayers. *“Pray without ceasing,”* the Scriptures tell us. Pray standing, seated, in bed, or kneeling, with humble and penitent heart, with thankful and hope-filled heart. **Pastors, the District 100th Anniversary Committee encourages you to use these daily intercessions seven per week, week by week in your Church's Service folders and/or newsletters.** Saint and commemoration days are included; however, we do not pray for the departed but rather that their lives may be examples of faith in Christ and godly service.

The last day of final 366 days in the 1,000 days of prayer remembers the martyrdom of Saint Robert Barnes. Barnes was the first Lutheran martyr for our Lord in England; he actually died on July 30th, 1540. The Worship Center at the English District Office is named in his memory as one who sought to bring the Reformation to England according to the truths of God's holy Word and with the Lord Jesus Christ as the heart and center of Christianity, not pope or bishop or emperor, queen or king.
